Eligibility/Seeding: USCSA—Rocky Mtn. Conference Ski Teams, Seniors, JI-JIII. Only one team from each college is seeded according to coach's discretion. Secondary team members and/or competitors who are not USCSA eligible college competitors will start according to their USSA points. All athletes **MUST** have a current USSA License to participate.

Entry Procedure: Each Team Captain must submit one USSA Team Entry Form per gender. Only one team per college is seeded according to coach's discretion.
